



Moving into Year 2

Start and finish of the day:

When we return to school in September Year 2 will **start school and 8.30am and finish at 2.30pm.**

All children will enter and leave school through the gate at the front of school.

Due to current guidelines parents are unable to come into school with their child at the start of the day. We ask that if you would like to speak to the class teacher to arrange to do so at the end of the school day.

PE:

Please make sure your child has their labelled P.E. kit in school every day.

They will need:

- White t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Black pumps

In September the Year 2 PE day will be on a Friday.

Snack and milk:

Children can have toast every morning. Please pay for this on Parent Pay (£1.25 for the week). If you would like your child to have milk, please pay via ParentPay for the term. If you are unsure how to access ParentPay please contact the school office.

Reading books:

Reading book and records will be kept in school for the time being and monitored by teaching staff. Your child will have lots of opportunities for individual reading including their own reading book and through guided reading. There will be many reading opportunities throughout the school week but as books cannot be taken home for now, any extra support with this at home is greatly appreciated.

Homework:

Spellings will be sent home on a Friday and tested the following Friday. Purple Mash is our online learning platform and this is where the majority of our homework will be set. Every child has a Purple Mash login and will use this to access their homework whilst at home. If you are unsure what this log in is then please ask your child's teacher.

Our topic:

When we return in September our main topic will be: **What a wonderful World** which has a Geography focus.

The children return to school on Monday 7th September and finish for half term on Friday 23rd October.
