

To develop our **reading** we will:

Participate in Guided Reading sessions every day where we will be exploring a range of different question types. Don't forget for you or your grown up to write into your diary that you have read. Remember 5 times a week or more and you get a green sticker. Spend time in our class reading area exploring fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts. Answer questions about what we have read.

To improve our **writing** we will:

Continue to work on grammar skills and use a range of punctuation correctly when writing different sentence types. We will continue to develop our range of exciting vocabulary and use this when writing for a range of different purposes. We are also continuing to develop our handwriting.

In **DT** we will:

Be designing and making our own vehicle. We will be evaluating what we make and considering how to improve it for next time.

We will be developing our **physical skills** we will be doing Games.

In **RE** we will explore Judaism and Christianity.

As **musicians** we will be:

Taught by our visiting experienced Music teacher this half term.

Reading

Please try to read as often as you can with your child at home. Look out for your child bringing home their extended book. They can read this book at their own pace whilst reading for enjoyment.

To develop our **Maths** we are:

Exploring addition and subtraction. Some of us will be using the column method and some of us will use the partitioning method.

Developing our knowledge of multiplication and division. We will be applying our knowledge in problem solving questions.

Telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.

Don't forget to keep practising the 2, 5, 10 times tables and their corresponding division facts.

This half term we will be revising and consolidating our knowledge in preparation for our SATs. Don't hesitate to chat to a member of staff if you have any questions about what these involve.
